## Plaid Cymru Working Together

Over £2 million has been secured for the Village since Councillor Siân Gwenllian was elected to Gwynedd Council 3 years ago.

- Councillor Gwenllian helped developers find a site for a brand new Surgery and Health Centre for the Village at Rowen. The £1.75 million Centre will employ 40 people and provide modern facilities with plenty of parking.
- Work is now complete on a major upgrade to the Memorial Hall giving the Village a top class venue for sports, community, youth and charity events. The project has been made possible by Councillor Gwenllian's successful bid for over a £250,000 Welsh Assembly grant and full backing by the Community Council.
- Work is well underway to improve popular mid-village walking and cycling routes thanks to a joint effort by Gwynedd Council and Councillor Gwenllian. The project was made possible with another large Welsh Assembly Government grant worth nearly £250,000.

"My aim is to improve life in the village as my first term in office has proved. Being able to work with fellow Plaid Cymru member Alun Ffred Jones means we can push forward important projects to improve the health and well-being of our constituents," said Councillor **Siân Gwenllian**. **Alun Ffred Jones**, Welsh Heritage Minister, who is standing for re-election this May said: "It's been great to visit Felin to see these projects moving on and I hope we can continue to work together in the future."
