Health centre go-ahead

DESPITE a last-minute intervention from Cadw, a plan to build a new health centre at Felinheli has been approved by councillors.

Cadw feared the new centre would be built near a former hill fort where the Romans crossed the Menai.

But Cllr Sian Gwenllian who represents the Felinheli ward on Gwynedd Council argued the site is well away from the fort and the centre will vastly improve health facilities in the village.

"I'm delighted it was given the all-clear by my fellow councillors," she said.

£200k leisure money

A £200,000 Welsh Assembly grant will improve community facilities in the Caernarfon and Bangor areas.

Gwynedd Council secured the cash from the Môn a Menai fund.

Bangor Swimming Pool and Arfon Leisure Centre, Caernarfon will both be upgraded. Canolfan Noddfa community centre in Caernarfon, has received £4,000 towards installing solar panels.

Parc Coed Helen, Caernarfon gets £80,000 and £6,000 goes towards improving energy use at the Outdoor Activity Centre in Rhyd Ddu.
