* **Tai I bobl leol :** Yr unig angen am dai yn y pentref yw'r angen am dai I bobl leol o bob math. **Mewn Arolwg Tai Lleol yn Hydref 2005 roedd 84% o blaid tai fforddiadwy.**

* **Datblygiadau newydd ar y gweill :** 1130 o dai sydd yn y ward (Mai 2006). O fewn ffin datblygu presennol Y Felinheli , mae un datblygiad mawr ar y gweill ger yr ysgol fel rhan o'r Cynllun Unedol (52 o dai) ac mae cae arall gerllaw wedi ei glustnodi ar gyfer ei ddatblygu(dros 30 o dai). Mae 7 o dai newydd wedi eu hadeiladu o fewn y ffin yn ddiweddar. Mae 7 o dai unigol (mawr) newydd wrthi'n cael eu codi ar hyn o bryd ac mae o leiaf 45 o ganiatâdau cynllunio yn bodoli yn barod ond heb eu gweithredu. Mae hyn yn gwneud cyfanswm o 141, sy'n golygu y gallai'r pentref dyfu 10% CYN unrhyw Gynllun Datblygu newydd. Mae hyn yn hen ddigon ac yn profi'r angen am statws gwarchodaeth.

* **Tai sydd eu hangen :** Yr angen yn Y Felinheli yw tai fforddiadwy i bobl ifanc, tai cymdeithasol a thai cymdeithasol llai i bobl oedrannus er mwyn caniatáu iddyn nhw symud o dai rhent cymdeithasol 3 llofft er mwyn eu rhyddhau i deuluoedd ifanc. Beth nad oes angen yw gwneud Y Felinheli yn bentref lloeren i weithwyr y trefi cyfagos. Mae'r Cyngor Cymuned wedi adnabod tair safle fechan ble gellid datblygu stadau ar gyfer pobol leol yn unig a rheini o fewn ffin y pentref. Mae un llecyn wrth stad Cartrefi Cymunedol Gwynedd yn Y Wern fyddai'n addas ar gyfer tai henoed. Mae llecyn arall ar Ffordd Caernarfon fyddai'n addas fel rhes o dai fforddiadwy i brynwyr tro cyntaf ac mae llecyn arall ar waelod Pen y Bryn wedi ei adnabod,eto er mwyn ateb angen lleol yn unig.

Within the present development boundaries, there is a large development afoot near the school as part of the Unitary Development Plan (52 houses) and another field by the Wern has been earmarked for development. (over 30 houses). 7 new houses have been built within the boundary recently. Another 7 large houses are being built. There are at least 45 planning permissions that have not yet been implemented. This makes a total of 141, which means the village could grow 10% BEFORE any new Development Plan. This is enough and proves the need for some sort of protected status.

The Community Council has noted three small sites where small estates for local people only could be built. These are within the village boundary. One is near the Wern and owned by Gwynedd Community Homes which would be suitable for housing for the elderly. There is another site on Ffordd Caernarfon which would be suitable as a row of affordable housing and there is another site at the bottom of Pen y Bryn again for local need only.

*The natural environment: Y Felinheli is surrounded by the Menai, Y Faenol Estate and agricultural land. The Menai has protected status. Protecting the natural beauty, special amenities and the valuable agricultural land is another argument for protecting the village.

Protect the village from any housing development unless it satisfies local demand in sites that have been offered by the Community Council within the present boundary

The natural environment: Y Felinheli is surrounded by the Menai, Y Faenol estate and agricultural land. The Menai has protected status. Protecting the natural beauty, special amenities and the valuable agricultural land is another argument for protecting the village.

CONCLUSIONS

The new Plan should

1)protect the existing development boundary

2)protect the village from any housing development unless it satisfies local demand in sites that have been offered by the Community Council within the present boundary

3)include areas to be kept as open or leisure spaces or as employment zones as noted by the Community Council on the map

The map has been on display at Y Felin Sgwrsio and several have voiced their agreement with the plan. Residents in the Marina do not want to see additional housing. It is considered that pressure is being exerted on the Welsh Government to increase the number of houses. Y Felinheli have taken the initial step.

A suggestion that a copy of the report be sent to One Voice Wales was supported.

Cymdeithas Hanes £100 towards a bus – trip for members, computer equipment,

visiting speakers fees; Cylch Meithrin £200 for various playing equipment; Regatta £150 towards the purchase of new flags; Clwb y Felin £150 to pay for guest speakers and chapel rent; Cyfeillion yr Ysgol £200 contribution towards improvements to the outside yard. Total £2500. In addition a payment of £500 to the Church as a contribution towards the maintenance and upkeep of Llanfairisgaer Cemetery.

£1000 has been earmarked since last year towards the multi purpose playing field and it was decided to earmark a further £500 to meet individual applications that are received during the year. AGREED to contribute £75 towards the costs of Ffion Mair Roberts, 3 Jubilee Terrace, Y Felinheli on her selection to play for the under 16 Welsh Girls Football Squad on their visit to Spain in April. As an acknowledgement, Ffion will be expected to demonstrate her skills to school children on her return from Spain.

Councillors' Report Feb 2012

1)Improvements on the green slope opposite Londis . Grant has been approved by Tidy Towns. Gardening Club working with Gwynedd Council on scheme to plant lavender and place bench near the bus Shelter. Sketch plan in Felin Sgwrsio window.

2)Sustainable Communities : meeting to discuss the questionnaire on Feb 22.

3)Lon Las: Gwynedd Council is proceeding with work to create a new piece of cycle track on the old railway track between Allt Dinas and Ffordd Caernarfon (accessing the main road near the lay-by on Ffordd Caernarfon) The development will need planning permission and local people will be able to voice their opinions through the planning process. Letters from Community Council ready to distribute.

4)Drws y Coed / Tan y Maes Housing scheme. The plan for 52 houses has not yet been submitted.

5)Local Development Plan: comments have been submitted. Summary on Council website and presented to Community Council. Map in Felin Sgwrsio shows future

land use suggestions by Community Council. Cyngor Gwynedd will decide.

I met with a representative from Ffordd Heulyn residents and ensured him that the Community Council does not want to see any open land being lost from the Marina or any more houses being built there.

6) Recycling bins moved from Half Way about to be relocated in car park near Dock.

7) New Breakfast Club available in school. Governors given presentation about new school banding. Year 6 pupils holding traffic survey on Stryd Bangor.

8) Ice on pavements: I arranged for Council to grit during icy weather.
