



4.5	Afon Heulyn Flooding – further information has been received from Councillor Daniel Williams and Councillor Emyr Gareth that the issue is within the Faenol Estate which then has an effect on a property within Y Felinheli. The Clerk to contact Pentir Community Council and natural resource Wales.	CLERC
4.6	Penybryn Development – Councillor Daniel Williams stated that there was no need to look at the lease for the Community Council to see that the Penybryn development has encroached onto the Lon Las which is owned by Gwynedd Council. The Clerk to consult with Gwynedd’s Property Department.	CLERK
4.7	Councillor Daniel Williams was aware that there had been no litter picking event in the village for some time and that had promised to arrange but due to constraints on his time unfortunately this has not been done. 4.8	No response has been received from the Trunk Road Agency nor Gwynedd Council, but acknowledgement has been received from the North Wales Police regarding the implementation of a one-way system through the village when it is necessary to close the by-pass.	
4.9	Acknowledgement has been received from Gwynedd Council regarding recent highlight to highway matters, potholes around a BT manhole cover and a blocked gully on beach Road. The work has been passed to the highway inspector for inspection.
