Information came to hand that the restriction was not going ahead for the time being as the nesting period had begun. The tree felling will continue after the nesting period. Although the information came to hand the signs were left on site, Councillor Emyr Gareth arranged for them to be placed on their sides so that the information was not visible for the footpath users.</p> <p>Further to this Councillor Nerys John requested that the Council inform the Gwynedd Officers that the footpath is being used for access to the Football field and that they should consult with the Club when the work restarts.</p> <p>A verbal report was provided by Councillor Nerys John regarding current footpath matters.</p> <p>Rubbish is back in the Cerrig yr Afon river. Two years ago, a litter pick from the river was organised by volunteers and Daniel Griffiths from Keep Wales Tidy. Arranging another event would be of benefit. The Clerk to contact the officer.</p> <p>The footbridge on Footpath 23a in the Cefn Forrest has been repaired.</p>
