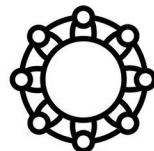
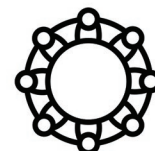
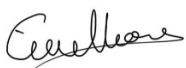

1.0	CHAIRMAN'S OPENIG REMARKS AND APOLOGIES	
	The Meeting was formally opened by Councillor Eifion Williams (Chairman). i. The following were elected as members of the Community Council as they are qualified to do so: Deiniol Tegid, Iolo Williams, Owain Jones, Siân Williams, and Gareth Humphreys. Three of them were welcomed to their first meeting. Siân and Gareth will attend in September. ii. Seimon, an officer of the Urdd, was welcomed to the meeting. The Urdd has now been holding sessions in the hall for young people in years 7 - 9 and primary school children for a year. To encourage these sessions, the Council has been providing the use of the Hall free of charge. Currently, the sessions take place weekly for years 7 - 9 and monthly for younger children. Reports were given on the types of activities being held, and it was necessary to look at how to develop sessions for primary school children. Currently, guidelines allow for 10 children per officer. If there are more children, it will be necessary to look for volunteers. It was decided that primary age sessions would be placed on the school calendar to remind parents of the sessions. It is also hoped to encourage volunteers to help others and with the sessions. The Council thanked the Officer for their presence and their work.	CLERK

4.0	CONFIRMATION OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES AND MATTERS ARISING	
4.1	Minutes for the month of May have been confirmed. Although a record was made for June, there was no quorum, so they could not be confirmed.	
4.2	Toilets - the start date for painting the building has been received, which is July 21st. There is access to water and electricity to the contractor through Gwynedd Council, and arrangements are in place. A report was received that the toilets are leaking and are perpetually wet; also, the light is not working in there. The Clerk is to report the deficiencies to the appropriate Officer in Gwynedd. 4.3	Traffic Management Plan - it has been received that no funding is available to implement the informal one-way scheme. It was decided that the clerk should send to Gwynedd Highways and Transportation to declare that the Council is not willing to wait until funding is available to implement; therefore, in the meantime, to request a suitable sign under lock on the site which would then be available for implementation by Gwynedd highways staff as needed. Also to request a price estimate for a suitable permanent license for the site at the cost of the Community Council.	CLERK
4.4	Football field bins on Lan y Môr Road - the work has been completed.	
4.5	Lan y Môr Sports Field - a planning application is being completed over the summer by the Clerk. A statement regarding flooding is required. A site visit has been made by the Property Department Officer and the Council Chair to discuss the lease. It has been decided that the lease would include the Football Field and the Small Boat Park. The lease will initially be for 7 years. However, it is necessary to confirm whether the initial lease period will affect the Council's opportunities to obtain grants. The Clerk to discuss this matter with the Property Officer.	CLERK/EG
4.6	Llwybr Cerrig yr Afon - no work has been done there so far. Temporary work as been carried out by the farmer. Councillor Eifion Williams will make inquiries and the contractor will see when the work will be completed.	CLERK/EW
4.7	Public transport in Y Felinheli - a response has come stating that if re-painting work is done on the bus stop on Bangor Road then they would start using the site again. It was decided that the Clerk would write to Gwynedd Highways	Clerc/EG



	stating that this work needs to be implemented as a priority. Arriva is also trialing one-way (single) fares based on distances with Transport for Wales on another service in September. If this trial is successful, they will then review other services. Until results are received, there will be no change in service fares.	
4.8	Highway Matters- i. Street lighting opposite Arfonnia - this work has been scheduled and is to be completed in the summer. ii. Overgrowth - work has started on this.	
4.9	Aberpwl kiosk - the clerk continues to work on the matter regarding the kiosk's adoptions.
