7.0	HIGHWAYS, BENCHES AND BUS SHELTERS	

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7.1	<p>Bridge across the river Heulyn – an explanation was provided by Councillor Emyr Gareth that the bridge had not been repaired since the gap allows any flood to go through rather than floor properties nearby. This arrangement is in place since 2015. This is in agreement with CADW. The National Trust is responsible for the culvert as it is on a private road. There is a need to remove the lintel that has fallen as it is an obstruction. The river Heulyn is a main river and therefore the responsibility of Natural Resource of Wales.</p> <p>The incident had been reported to the NRW and it hoped an update is received soon on the mater.</p>	
7.2	Prohibition of through traffic – Penscoins Road October 1 st , 2020 – Information on the resurfacing work.	
7.3	Grass cutting was discussed. A cut has taken place without it being collected. The Clerk stated that she has tried and tried to get hold of Geraint Hughes and has had no response to date. The County Councillor suggested the Clerk contact Steffan Jones and if no response is received, he would contact him personally. The playing field on Beach Road also need to have a cut. Information was received that the length of the grass was not obstructive to the field being used. There is much use of the playing field at the Wern.	
7.4	Review on the change to highway legislation – 20 mph limits. The Council supported the development.	
7.5	Parking Prohibition – Caernarfon Road near Menai Court – The Council supported the proposal.	
8.0	PUBLIC FOOTPATH AND LON LAS	
8.1	A report was received that there is Japanese knotweed growing on the side of the Lon Las – The Clerk to report this to the appropriate officer at Gwynedd Council.	CLERK

9.1	A report was received that the compost bins are being used for all materials. Councillor Nerys John had tried to clear it, but the work is too heavy. The bins are full of soil which requires to be moved. It was proposed and sconded that the Clerk should contact the Grass Cutting Contractor to see if he could arrange for it to be removed.	CLERK

	Councillor Daniel Williams presented a report on the meeting between the Community Council Representatives and the Engineers on Beach Road. There was a need for the Community Council to consider various materials for completion of the wall. The matter was discussed, and it was decided to recommend that Gwynedd Council stay true to the original scheme and provide slate slabs (riven) if costs were a factor. It was accepted that lime stones be used for the cock and hen structure. It was also requested if a fence could be placed on top of the wall for the playing field as moving the current fence to the wall would create a grass cutting problem.	
11.0	MEMORIAL HALL AND CLOCK	

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11.1	A verbal report was provided on a covid 19 risk assessment for the Hall. Councillor Daniel Williams stated that there was no need to hurry to reopen the hall as the usual activities for the hall did not commence until September. The Councillor stated that he and the Clerk would be looking at the risk assessment over the month to move forward with reopening the hall.	DW
